

The following are questions asked during the virtual UDO session held on 2/25/2026. Answers have been provided by the project team.

Q1: Outdoor Rifle Ranges are a permitted use in Rural Preservation? Just open one up next to your neighbor?

A: This is under review.

Q2: Once the zoning districts have been decided how easily can these be changed? Will they be set in perpetuity?

A: Zoning codes are living documents that can be amended at the will of the legislative body.

Q3: If a use is not permitted or conditional, can the planning commission override to allow a use?

A: No.

Q4: Missed last presentation. Where do I find units/acre allowed in the placetypes?

A: Units per acre are not assigned to place types.

Q5: Wild animal rescues - where would those be appropriate?
